Charleston, SC- Crescent Homes announces the extension of their philanthropy program, GIVE, to the Nashville area, partnering with 5 local nonprofits.

Crescent Homes was founded on the commitment to be progressive, to continuously strive for improvement and to always go beyond the standard. GIVE extends that mission beyond home building to spread awareness and goodwill throughout the communities in which it builds. The program works with various charities within the area to offer monetary support by donating \$250 for every home sale with no annual cap. Homebuyers are able to choose which foundation will receive a contribution in their name. The Nashville GIVE program will select 5 new foundations every six months.

Crescent Homes first launched GIVE in Charleston this past April with great success. After the initial three months of the program, Crescent Homes founder and CEO Ted Terry presented \$21,750 to five local Charleston nonprofits including Camp Happy Days, Charleston Animal Society, Habitat for Humanity, Be A Mentor, and Ronald McDonald House.
